

VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

Unless you're a 3rd grader or a VBS small group leader, you may not know who Anita Thiessen is. But that's okay with her.

"It's not about recognition. It's not about people saying, 'Wow, hey look at that.' It's about doing the things that Christ would do to serve other people."

And serving other people is what Anita, and her husband Eldon, have been faithfully doing for many years. The Thiessens came to Henderson Hills in 2009 to be closer to family and almost immediately sought out ways to serve. According to Eldon, "There are a lot of places that need people to serve. You just need to listen, look around, and ask questions. Ask, 'where can I serve?'"

As retired teachers, it was a natural fit to teach a Community Group. On Sunday mornings you'll find the Thiessens leading a group of enthusiastic 3rd graders.

Hillside Big Kids Director, Amy Ferguson says, "The Thiessens are really investing and impacting the children."

"Some of our hardest Sunday School kids will come up and give us hugs years after they leave our class. You know you've helped them along their way, even if just for that short amount of time," says Anita.

In addition to leading a Community Group, Anita also writes curriculum for VBS small groups and equips the small group leaders to be successful with the kids. Hillside Kids leadership adds, "Anita is meaningfully creative—enabling others to serve well."

Anita also serves in our English as a Second Language (ESL) Ministry, and Eldon is an active Deacon and co-leader of a Men's Bible Study. And with all this, they still make serving their family top priority. So, whether it's family, 3rd graders, ESL, or men, the Thiessens are committed to serving where God has placed them to make the most impact.

"Opportunities to serve are gifts God gives us...you have to move on it. You can't just ignore it," says Anita. Eldon adds, "You receive more blessing than what you give." Where is God calling you to serve?
