




## RECOVERING THE IMAGE OF GOD

At Ministries of Jesus, in our Recovery Ministry, we don't think about recovering from *something*, but rather we remind ourselves we are in the process of recovering the image of God—being who we are in Christ as He intended. If we focus on recovering from something we may be running away from whatever it is that has us captive. If, however, we are recovering the image of God, we are running toward something—or, Someone—a loving Father and Savior who offers forgiveness, freedom, and hope as a free gift.

God has blessed the Recovery Ministry at MOJ this past year. The MOJ Celebrate Recovery is now one of the largest in the state, partly due to the Triumph Series here at Henderson Hills. The church was able to receive first-hand witness to God's healing grace through amazing testimonies. Three more events in the Triumph Series are scheduled for 2019. From this exposure, Celebrate Recovery and Step Studies have seen a surge in attendance where people are finding healing for their hurts, habits, or hang-ups.

A focus of the Recovery Ministry at MOJ has always been to build a base of trained leaders to guide those seeking their potential in Christ so they can serve others. Recently, through gracious financial support, MOJ Recovery Ministry was able to send 28 individuals to Tulsa for a Celebrate Recovery "One-Day" training event. In addition, 12 of our primary leaders were able to attend the Celebrate Recovery Summit at Saddleback Church in August for a week of intensive education, worship, and workshops. The MOJ Recovery Ministry is equipped to support your needs and the needs of Henderson Hills in 2019!
