GROWING IN PRAYER

Intercessory prayer is a biblical priority and our heart is to be a praying church. It is our joy to share with you the experiences and growth of three of our students who have been changed by prayer, and specifically prayer walking, as an encouragement to each of you to step out in obedience in prayer. Here is what they felt led to share with you, their church family.

"I truly learned how to commune with the Lord. How to have a two-way conversation with Him!"

"I learned how to dwell in the presence of the Holy Spirit and follow Him wherever He physically or spiritually leads me. He leads me in what to pray for and where to go while praying. I think all followers of Christ should habitually prayer walk. It is an amazing way to deepen your relationship with Jesus and experience the Holy Spirit."

"It is beneficial for believers to pray and humble ourselves because life isn't all about us, we need Him above all! Interceding on behalf of communities and people is one of

the best ways to express and experience His love."

"Prayer walking taught me that you can pray for anything and ask God for small things or big, powerful things on behalf of others, believers and non-believers alike. We may not get to see the fruit of our prayers, but we can trust that God will always finish His work."

"Praying doesn't have to be formal.

It's a conversation between you and God and there is no need to feel intimidated."

"Prayer walking is just as important and just as powerful as evangelizing directly to a person. Even though you don't necessarily know what the specific needs of a neighborhood or city are, God knows. And going to Him on their behalf is an important act of obedience and part of what it means to live sent."
