1a	Welcomed	Matthew 10:40	<i>Anyone who welcomes you welcomes me, and anyone who welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me.</i>
1b	Welcomed	Acts 15:4	<i>When they came to Jerusalem, they were welcomed by the church and the apostles and elders, to whom they reported everything God had done through them.</i>
1c	Welcomed	1 Peter 4:9	<i>Be hospitable to one another without complaining.</i>
2a	Accepted	Romans 15:7	<i>Accept one another, then, just as Christ accepted you, in order to bring praise to God.</i>
2b	Accepted	Ephesians 4:2	<i>Conduct yourselves with all humility, gentleness, and patience. Accept each other with love.</i>
3a	Encouraged	Hebrews 3:13	<i>Encourage each other to stand firm in the faith every day, while it is still called "today", and beware that none of you becomes deaf and blind to God through the delusive glamour of sin. (Ph)</i>
3b	Encouraged	1 Thess. 5:11	<i>Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.</i>
3c	Encouraged	Philippians 1:6	<i>Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.</i>
5a	Challenged	Philippians 3:12-14	<i>Not that I have already obtained all this, or have already arrived at my goal, but I press on to take hold of that for which Christ Jesus took hold of me. Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.</i>
5b	Challenged	1 Peter 4:1-3	<i>Therefore, since Christ has suffered in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same purpose, because he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin, so as to live the rest of the time in the flesh no longer for the lusts of men, but for the will of God. For the time already past is sufficient for you to have carried out the desire of the Gentiles, having pursued a course of sensuality, lusts, drunkenness, carousing, drinking parties and abominable idolatries.</i>

5c	Challenged	Hebrew 10:24-25	<i>And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.</i>
5a	Missed	Ecclesiastes 4:9-10	<i>Two are better than one, because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up.</i>
5b	Missed	Philippians 4:1	<i>Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, dear friends!</i>
5c	Missed	2 Corinthians 3:13	<i>I still had no peace of mind, because I did not find my brother Titus there. So I said goodbye to them and went on to Macedonia.</i>
5d	Missed	2 Timothy 4:11	<i>Only Luke is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, because he is helpful to me in my ministry.</i>
6a	Reconciled	Isaiah 45:22	<i>Turn to me and be saved, all you ends of the earth; for I am God, and there is no other.</i>
6b	Reconciled	2 Corinthians 5:20	<i>We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God.</i>
6c	Reconciled	John 5:24	<i>Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.</i>
6d	Reconciled	2 Peter 3:9	<i>The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead, he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.</i>
7a	Abiding	John 15:5	<i>I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing.</i>
7b	Abiding	Acts 4:13	<i>When they saw the complete assurance of Peter and John, who were obviously uneducated and untrained men, they were staggered. They recognized them as men who had been with Jesus.</i>
7c	Abiding	Colossians 2:6-7	<i>And now just as you trusted Christ to save you, trust him, too, for each day's problems; live in vital union with him. Let your roots grow down into him and draw up nourishment from him. See that you go on growing in the Lord, and become strong and vigorous in the truth you were taught. Let your lives overflow with joy and thanksgiving for all he has done.</i>
8a	Maturing	2 Peter 3:18	<i>But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory, both now and to the day of eternity. Amen.</i>

8b	Maturing	Ephesians 4:14-15	<i>We are not meant to remain as children at the mercy of every chance wind of teaching and the jockeying of men who are expert in the craft presentation of lies. But we are meant to hold firmly to the truth in love, and to grow up in every way into Christ, the head.</i>
9a	Loving	John 13:34-35	<i>“A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”</i>
9b	Loving	1 John 3:18	<i>Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.</i>
9c	Loving	Romans 12:10	<i>Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves.</i>
9d	Loving	Mark 12:29-31	<i>Jesus answered, “The most important [command] is, ‘Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.’ The second is this: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no other commandment greater than these.”</i>
10a	Serving	Galatians 5:13	<i>You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love.</i>
10b	Serving	Matthew 20:25-27	<i>Jesus called them together and said, “You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be your slave.</i>
11a	Fighting	1 Timothy 6:12	<i>Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses.</i>
11b	Fighting	Ephesians 6:11-12	<i>Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.</i>
11c	Fighting	1 Timothy 1:18	<i>This charge I entrust to you, Timothy, my child, in accordance with the prophecies previously made about you, that by them you may wage the good warfare.</i>
12a	Investing	John 4:32-34	<i>But he said to them, “I have food to eat that you know nothing about.” Then his disciples said to each other, “Could someone have brought him food?” “My food,” said Jesus, “is to do the will of him who sent me and to finish his work.</i>

12b	Investing	John 6:27	<i>Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him God the Father has placed his seal of approval.”</i>
12c	Investing	Matthew 6:33	<i>But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.</i>
12d	Investing	Luke 12:15-21	<i>Then he said to them, “Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions.” And he told them this parable: “The ground of a certain rich man yielded an abundant harvest. He thought to himself, ‘What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.’ “Then he said, ‘This is what I’ll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store my surplus grain. And I’ll say to myself, “You have plenty of grain laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry.” “But God said to him, ‘You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?’ “This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God.”</i>
12e	Investing	Matthew 16:25-26	<i>For whoever wants to save their life will lose it, but whoever loses their life for me will find it. <sup>26</sup> What good will it be for someone to gain the whole world, yet forfeit their soul? Or what can anyone give in exchange for their soul?</i>
